Today the Congregation of the Sisters of Bon Secours of Paris joyfully announce that we will accept the invitation extended by the Vatican Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development to participate in a seven year journey toward sustainability in the spirit of Pope Francis' landmark encyclical, *Laudato Si'*.

This initiative, the Laudato Si' Action Platform (LSAP), is a call to the universal Church – families, parishes and dioceses, educational and healthcare institutions, organizations and religious orders – to take concrete steps toward a sustainable future in the spirit of Laudato Si'. Over these next seven years the Congregation of Bon Secours hopes to be part of the critical mass needed to create a global paradigm shift which is nothing short of a transformation of our relationship with Earth and all who share our common home. In the coming year, in collaboration with the Bon Secours Family, we will assess what we are already doing to address the goals of Laudato Si', dream of what more could be possible and design a plan that will enable us to more fully realize this vision of Pope Francis' encyclical over the next seven years. We pray for the grace to be open to what God desires to do through us for the healing of Earth.
